The goal of these special sessions is to provide a forum for focused discussions on new topics or innovative applications of established approaches. A special session could address a particular theme or consist of work done in some particular international project.

SPECIAL SESSION PROPOSALS

Special Session **proposals** must contain the following information:

- Title of the proposed Special Session;
- Names, affiliations, and contact information of the session organizers;
- Brief biographies of the session organizers;
- Brief description of the proposed session with a list of the related topics.

Papers submitted to special sessions will undergo the same review process as regular papers, where the Special Session Organizers are responsible for organizing the peer-review process. If a Special Session has a low number of accepted papers, these may be combined with other special sessions wherever possible, or moved to the regular track.
